


The data collected has been analyzed and the results are described below.


- 89.47 % of teachers agreed that Current Syllabus is adequately covering basic

- > 73.68% of teachers agreed that sufficient reference material and books are available for the topics mentioned in the syllabus.







- ➢ 87.85% students are agreed that that the present curriculum is very suitable for employability.


















FEEDBACK FROM PARENTS

- ▶ 88.89% parents agreed that the Parent Teacher Communication is good.





































FEEDBACK FROM EMPLOYER

Following questions are used to get feed back from employer about the employees who were completed their UG/PG Programmes from this college. 18 employers participated in the survey.






