## **Findings:**

- 95.43% of the students agreed that teachers are completed the syllabus in time.
- 93.02% of the students agreed that teachers are punctual in the class.
- 87.06% of the students agreed that teachers have good communication skills.
- 90.86% of the students agreed that teachers are prompt to ask question in the classrooms.
- 88.20% of the students agreed that teachers illustrate the concepts through examples
- 40.36% of the students agreed that teachers are using ICT tools while teaching.
- 85.91% of the students agreed that teachers encourage the students in participating extra-curricular activities.
- 80.58% of the students agreed that teaching and mentoring in the institution is good.
- 60.66% of the students agreed that teachers are inculcating your soft skills, life skills, employability skills, etc to make you ready for your career.
- 80.20% of the students agreed that sufficient number of prescribed books are available in the library.
- 89.47% of the students agreed that facilities like class rooms, toilet, internet etc are adequate in the institution.
- 94.42% of the students agreed that internal evaluation is fair and impartial.
- 90.86% of the students agreed that the rapport with teachers/administrative staff is good.
- 88.58% of the students agreed that the learning atmosphere in the college is good.
- 87.18% of the students agreed that the overall quality of teaching – learning process in the institution is good.

**Concluding remark:**

The Student Satisfaction Survey 2023-24 report has been analysed and it is found that students are generally satisfied with the teaching learning environment provided by the institution. Still, two areas are found to be in need of improvement.

1. Use of ICT by the teachers
2. Inculcating the soft skill, life skills, employability skill, etc.
